Day 1 - GEORGETOWN/WILMINGTON/WINSTON-SALEM, NC

Day 2 - WINSTON-SALEM/ASHVILLE

Morning visit at the **Reynolda House Museum of American Art** for a guided tour of the large country house which offers a fine collection of furnishings and American paintings, prints and sculpture. The works of Mary Cassatt, Frederic Church, John Singleton Copley, Gilbert Stuart and Andrew Wyeth are represented. The out buildings have been converted into the Village Shopping Center with interesting shops and restaurants, including the Village Tavern. Day 3 - ASHEVILLE

Today visit the great **Biltmore Mansion**. In 1887 George Vanderbilt selected architect Richard Morris Hunt to build his mansion in the style of a French chateau. At one time it was the largest private home in America. Tour independently with an audio tape. Lunch at the Deerpark Restaurant on the estate. After lunch you may return to the mansion to see more and to visit the shops. Mid-afternoon guided tour of Asheville, a city of distinctive architecture including outstanding art-deco buildings.
