Day 1 - GEORGETOWN/WILMINGTON/WOBURN, MA

Day 2 - BOSTON/NORTH CONWAY, NH

A morning guided tour of this historic city includes views of the Old State House and the South Meeting House and a visit to Old North Church. Lunch independently at Faneuil Hall before continuing to North Conway, NH, your home for two nights.

Day 3 - CONWAY RAILROAD/KANCAMANGUS SCENIC BYWAY

Board the Notch Train and enjoy some of the finest scenery in the East as you travel through spectacular Crawford Notch, past sheer bluffs, steep ravines, and across the famed Frankenstein Trestle and Willey Brook Bridge enroute to Fabyan Station. On a clear day you will be able to view Mt. Washington, New England's highest peak. Lunch included aboard the train. Spectacular fall foliage should surround you. Return to North Conway via the Kancamangus Scenic Byway in the White Mountain National Park. [Meals BL](#)

Day 4 - NORTH CONWAY/SHELBURNE FARMS

Drive through New Hampshire to the Shelburne Inn, VT, for a delightful lunch. Afterwards a tour of Shelburne Farms which introduces you to life in Vermont today taking you behind-the-scenes to explore the horse barn and meet the cheese makers. Overnight in south Burlington. [Meals BL](#)

Day 5 - MORGAN HORSE FARM/BENNINGTON MUSEUM/PITTSFIELD, MA

Almost hidden in Weybridge, VT is the University Morgan Horse Farm, an absolute gem among the state's attractions. Morgan horses are one of the earliest breeds developed in the United States. The foals will be roaming the pastures and the horses are always in beautiful shape. A guided tour will let you meet the mares and stallions at this delightful farm. Continue south to Bennington, VT for a look at the cemetery where Robert Frost is buried, the Old First Church and the Bennington Battle Monument. Afterwards visit the museum who's collections include paintings by Grandma Moses and other American artists, an extensive array of American glass, and a renowned display of 19th century pottery. Overnight in Pittsfield, MA. Meals BD

Day 6 - THE MOUNT/HOME

Visit Edith Wharton's elegant 1902 estate in the Berkshire Mountains of Western Massachusetts. Here, this Pulitzer prize-winning American author fashioned a world of beauty and calm in which she could write in peace and entertain distinguished friends. It was here that she created some of her greatest works, including "The House of Mirth" and "Ethan Frome". Lunch nearby before departing for Wilmington. Meals BL
